Dear Parents & Carers,

RE: COVID 19 SITUATION IN VICTORIA

Due to the changing COVID 19 situation in Victoria, the Premier has announced a 5-day lockdown from 11.59 p.m. tonight. These restrictions will impact on school operations.

All students must learn from home, unless their parents are authorised, permitted workers. At this stage, we are expecting school to return next Wednesday 21st July, however, you will be updated by the school to confirm this.

Children of authorised, permitted workers will be able to come to school tomorrow. If this applies to your child, please email the school, as you are required approval to attend. There will be an application form for Monday & Tuesday, made available from tomorrow afternoon.

Teachers will be preparing to move to Remote Learning. All year levels will be using the SeeSaw platform for Remote Learning. All students were asked to take home a workbook and a pencil case today. Due to the short notice, we will be posting student work up on SeeSaw by 9am. Please complete all work in the workbook and upload it to SeeSaw by taking a photo of your child's work.

If your child does not have a device to access SeeSaw, your child is to complete all work in their workbook and return their book to school next Wednesday, 21st July. Please mark your child's attendance on SeeSaw or call the office to advise of your child's attendance if you cannot access SeeSaw.

The COVID situation in Victoria is very serious. It is vitally important that everyone observes the Health advice and new restrictions.

There are only five reasons to leave your home:

1. Shopping for essential goods within five kilometres from your home.
2. Exercise for two hours within five kilometres from your home.
3. Permitted, authorised workers to go to and from work.
4. Care giving for compassionate reasons.
5. To get vaccinated.

Masks must be worn everywhere indoors and outdoors; no visitors can come to your home; no public gatherings. If you need any help or advice please email or call the school office, we are always here to help. kilberry.valley.ps@education.vic.gov.au
